Priorities of the Hungarian presidency

On 1 July 2024, Hungary will assume the rotating presidency of the Council of the European Union, succeeding Belgium. Following the recent EU elections,

the Hungarian Presidency aims to ensure the continuity of work within the Council, in collaboration with the newly established European Parliament and European Commission. It will also commence the implementation of the Strategic Agenda 2024–2029. Among its key priorities, Hungary highlights the adoption of a New European Competitiveness Deal to restore economic development, create conditions for sustainable growth, deepen the internal market, support small and medium-sized enterprises, and promote both the green and digital transitions. EFCA welcomes that the Hungarian presidency focusses on important issues of the green and digital agenda, giving priority to energy policies and sustainable industrial growth.
