Project Background:	Design and Construction of a Solar PV Plant of minimum 100 MWac with grid connection facilities. The present prequalification is to select a suitable contractor for the engineering, procurement and construction of the facility on a single EPC turnkey basis. The contractor will perform all work for the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ A ground mounted PV power plant with around 130 MW_p (or higher) / 100 MVA capacity, including all associated infrastructure➤ A 33/110 kV high voltage transformer substation with 2 or 3 transformers and 33 kV medium voltage switchboards, including control building➤ A 110 kV double circuit underground connection line to the substation "Kosovo A" located around 2 km north to the PV plant.➤ A new equipment bay at the substation "Kosovo A"
Requested Services:	Through this prequalification procedure, Korporata Energetike e Kosovës sh.a. (KEK) requests closed bids (electronic submission, see below in Bidding procedure) from eligible bidders who meet the required qualifications for the Design and Construction of a Solar PV Plant of minimum 100 MWac with grid connection facilities.

Shortlisting of Contractors is planned for March 2026. The implementation period is estimated at approximately 18 months starting from signing of the contract and excluding the warranty period. The start of the project implementation is planned in March 2027 and the end of commissioning is expected in November 2028.

Bidding procedure:

The Contract is planned to be implemented under the FIDIC general conditions of contract (Yellow Book).

The Employer intends to shortlist the requested services to eligible Applicants. Eligible Applicants are all independent and qualified companies with experience in the sector of Energy Infrastructure since at least 1st July 2020.

The Applicant shall present an average annual turnover of *forty Million Euros (40 000 000 €)* since beginning of 2021, calculated as total certified annual payments received for contracts in progress and/or completed.
